It was a remarkable year of continued dedication to our mission of supporting children and families in need, and we are grateful for your unwavering support that has allowed us to make a meaningful difference in the lives of so many.

In our 42nd year of operation, we are proud to report that we provided vital support to more than 800 families in 2022. These families came to us during their most challenging times, seeking comfort and care while their children received medical treatment at Mayo Clinic. Our doors were open to them, providing a home away from home, a place where they can find solace and support from our compassionate staff, volunteers, and fellow families facing similar journeys.

Throughout the year, we provided nearly 10,000 nights of free lodging to these families. We understand that the financial and emotional burdens of caring for a sick child can be overwhelming, and we are committed to easing these burdens by offering a safe and welcoming environment, where families can stay together and find comfort in each other's company.

In addition to lodging, we served more than 9,000 meals to our families in 2022. We are serving more families than ever before, and the additional programs and support are critical to the families at our House.

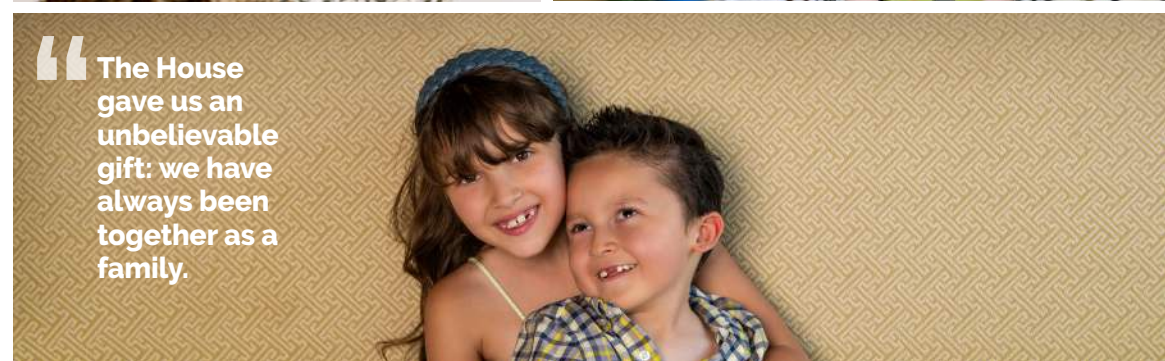

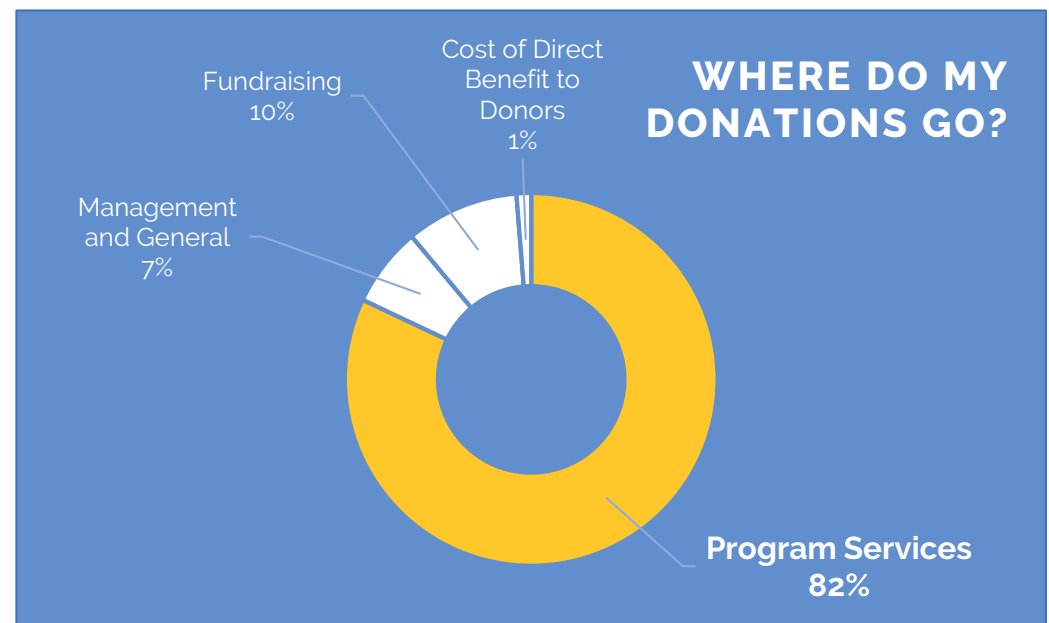
